

AKC TRICK TITLES



There are **4** levels of Trick Titles: Novice, Intermediate, Advanced and Performer! So how many tricks can **YOUR** dog perform?!

NOVICE TITLE - TKN

To obtain the Novice Trick Title, your dog must complete 10 Tricks from the approved list. However, if your dog already has a CGC Title, then you only need to have your dog learn 5 new tricks! For the Novice Title - food and toy lures may be used.

INTERMEDIATE TITLE - TKI

To obtain the Intermediate Trick Title, your dog must complete an additional 10 tricks from the approved list. CGC title is **not** required, but the tricks must be additional to any that were learned for the Novice Title. For Intermediate Title you may **not** use food or toy lures, but can use rewards.

ADVANCED TITLE - TKA

To obtain the Advanced Trick Title, your dog must complete an additional 10 trick from the approved list. CGC title is **not** required, but the tricks must be additional to any that have been

learned in the Novice, and Intermediate Titles. For Advanced Title you may **not** use food or toy lures, but can use rewards.

PERFORMER TITLE - TKP

To obtain the Performer Title - your dog must already have the previous 3 titles. Additionally, the dog and handler team must perform 10 tricks - that must include 2 intermediate, and 2 advanced tricks - in a routine. The routine may have a theme, or story. No food **lures** may be used at this level, but you may **reward** your dog after a series of moves.

6ft leash, and long lines may be used. Food and treats are permitted during the test, but you may praise and encourage your dog as you go.
